Since the beginning of 2020, the CPS Foundation has been on a journey to help address the child care needs within the Columbus community.

"With help from our partners and several grants, we are nearing completion on the Kramer Child Development Center," CPS Foundation Director Nicole Anderson said.

Without our partners our vision of providing purposeful play to support the development of children would not have been possible.

Our goals with this child development center is not simply to provide child care, but an environment that supports and prepares children for preschool and kindergarten. In addition a partnership with Columbus High School and Central Community College



Although she didn't compete in the Miss Nebraska pageant until she was midway through college, Jodi was quite familiar with the

pageant circuit.

She had provided extra entertainment as a dancer for the Miss Columbus pageant when she was in high school, and through that gig, had gotten to know some of the people involved with the pageant.

So, when she decided to compete herself in the Miss Omaha pageant (she was a student at University of Nebraska Omaha), it wasn't a total stretch. Dancing was her talent, of course, and her skills as a dancer were what pushed her over the edge to win Miss Nebraska.

Jodi loved the experience. "The interview skills that I learned when I was competing really helped prepare me for the rest of my life," she said. "And I loved the opportunity to meet so many women from across the country and have the chance to perform so much."

The scholarship was a big plus, too — Jodi graduated from college debt-free. She now lives in Omaha with her husband and works as the general manager for the Alzheimer's division at a biotechnology company.
