# CHS Alum, Pulitzer winner reflects on career

Blessen begins her story following graduation in 1969. "Well, I stayed in Nebraska for a bit, went to Lincoln University, Nebraska. After graduating with a degree in painting and sculpture, Blessen traveled to New York in 1977.

"I really wanted to I wanted to find a path that I could make a living doing what

I loved, which was was creating, which was making art. And so and in New York City was a very good place to do it because you couldn't get away with any foolishness, you know, and if you wanted to get hired again," she said.

Two years later her husband's job as a geologist took them to Dallas where Blessen continued to work as a writer and artist. In 1989, Blessen won a Pulitzer Prize (Explanatory Reporting) for her graphic design work with writers David Hanners and William Snyder on a special section called "Anatomy of an Air Crash," that appeared in the Dallas Morning News.

"There was no way that I thought when I was in my art class in Columbus

High that I was going to be a Pulitzer Prize winner: I wouldn't have believed it." she said.

Her career would continue for another decade, until a moment changed her course. "I was forever changed as I learned the impact and the cost of one act of violence," she said.

Blessen witnessed a murder outside her Dallas home in August of 2000. She wrote "One Bullet," a deeply personal story published in The Dallas Morning News in 2003 but her experiences and connection to art led to a bigger project, 29 Pieces.

"I wanted to take what I knew, which was asked to begin working with children from kindergarten through 12th grade to use art to teach nonviolence. 29 pieces has been a real it's been a real challenge for me and it's been a real point of pride," she said.

The '29' came from a series of 29 sculptures that Blessen based on deep spiritual questions. "We broke it down into palatable chunks," she said. "We talk about commitment; we talk about thriving; we talk about hope; we talk about forgiveness."

The project has worked with more than 150,000 kids in 25 states and trained more than 1,500 teachers.

"I feel very, very fortunate to have felt what I wanted to do early on and to have found a way to continue to do it," she said.




